John French's lidded box demonstrates fantastic technique and design. Technically this is a difficult piece to make given the precise contouring of the 'square' box. The turning up of the four corners of the top of the box beautifully balances the piece. Topped with a precise and crisp finial it is worthy of first place



Mike Charnley made a perfected sphere box with rotary cut decoration. Typical for pieces made by Mike it is beautifully executed and finely finished.

Michael has used metal flake applied to the lid and framed with two burn lines. This attention to detail and its appropriate width lifts the piece into another level and is very effective.
